

Dimensional Bodies (60 minutes, color slides and sound)

A collaborative project of photographer **Johunna Grayson** and filmmaker **Greta Snider**

Dimensional Bodies is a collection of intimate stereoscopic slideshow portraits. Using spoken narrative and environmental soundscape to illuminate an array of subjects, including a farmer, a social worker, an athlete and a robot-maker, the portraits focus on issues of aging, addiction, vitality, sexual identity, and other concerns of the physical body.

The stereoscopic aspect of the portraits puts an additional emphasis on the physical experience of viewing, accentuating the human mechanics of vision.

We are particularly interested in the "motion" aspect of the hand-processed textures (which create slight textural differences between the two stereo images, and create a feeling of movement as a viewers' eyes balance them). This phenomenon is called "retinal rivalry," and is part of the neuroscience of human vision in a way that is at once intimate and universal.
